**This is the Torah that Moshe placed before the Children of Israel,¹
upon the command of Adonai, through Moshe's hand.²**

It is a tree of life for those who grasp it, and its supporters are praiseworthy.³ Its ways are ways of pleasantness and all its paths are peace.⁴ Lengthy days are at its right; at its left are wealth and honor.⁵ HaShem desired, for the sake of its [Israel's] righteousness, that the Torah be made great and glorious.⁶
